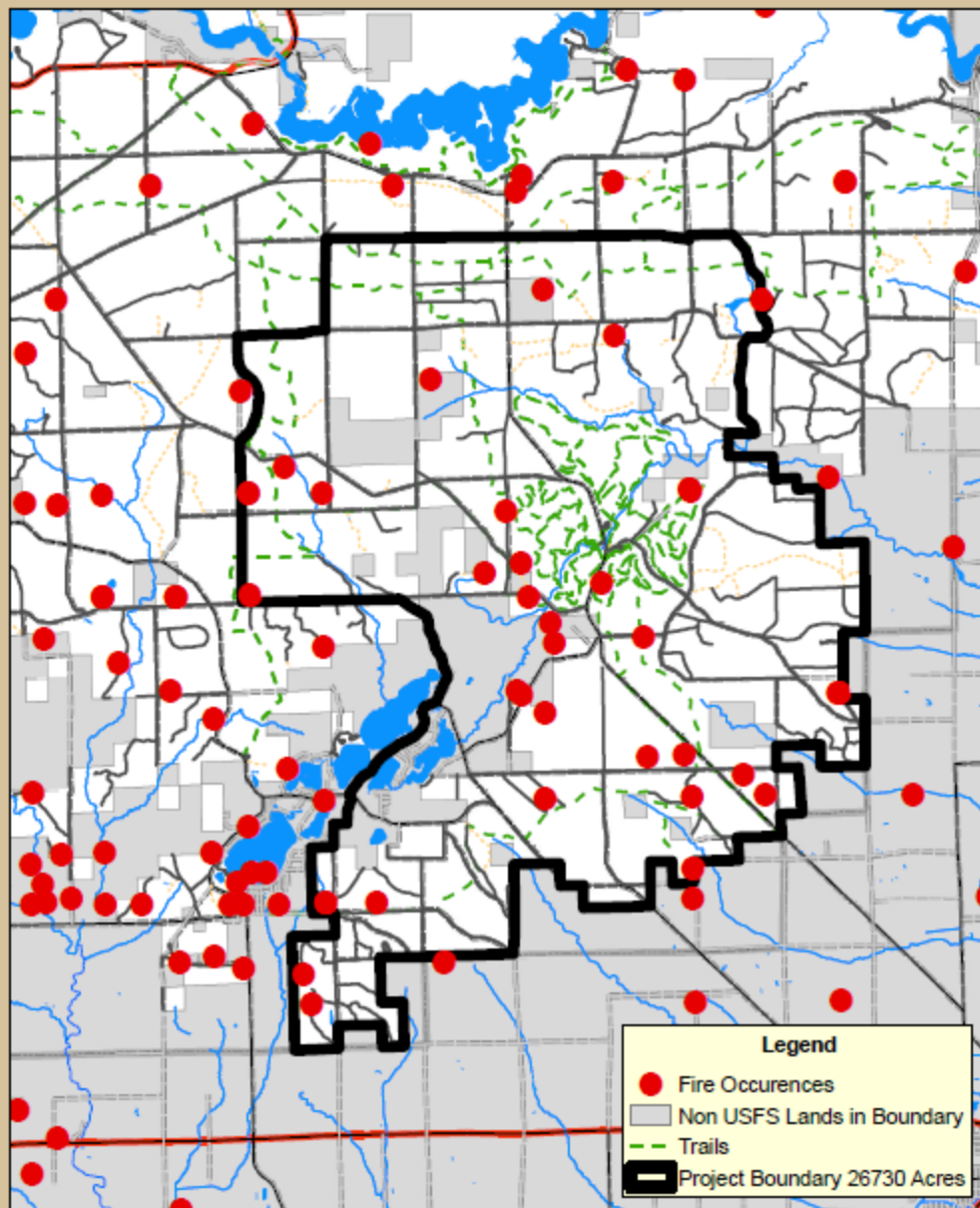

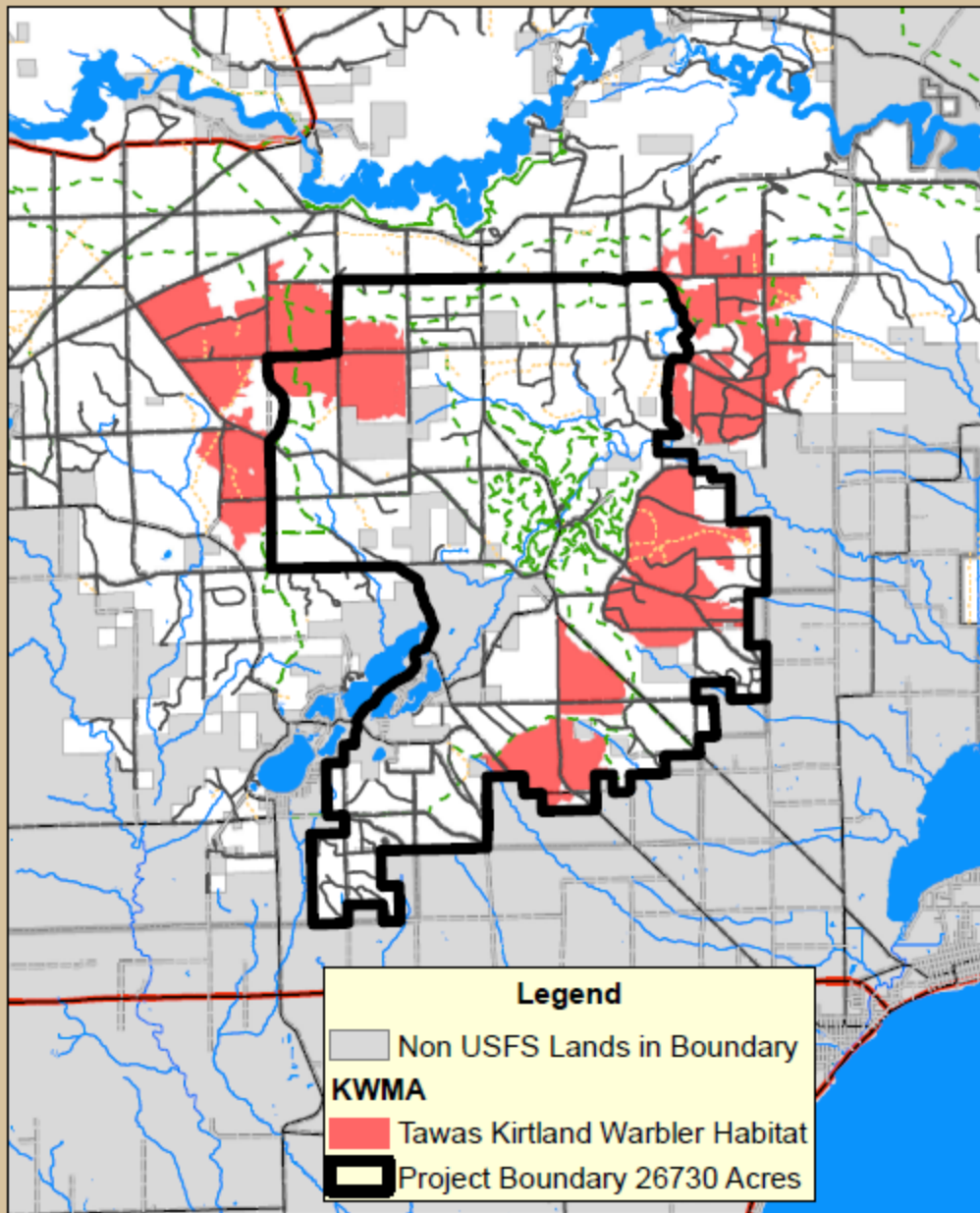

1979-2009

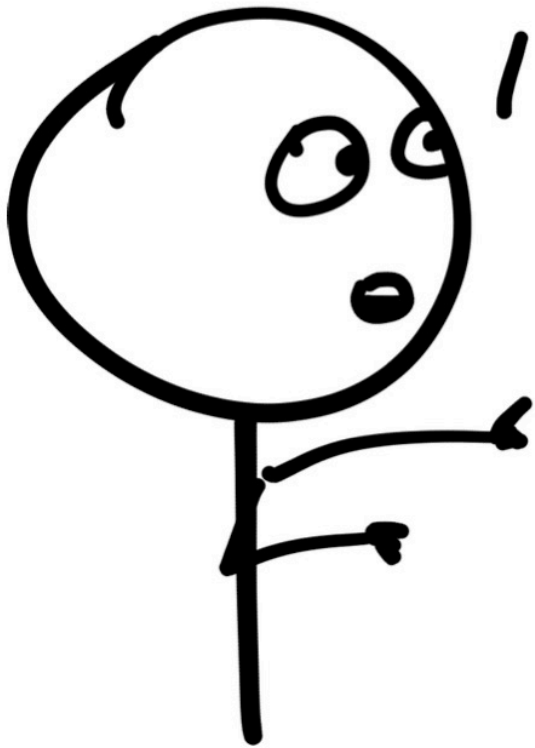
